Action taken in response to issues raised by constituents June 2012 –

Hepburn Gardens – five potholes filled.

Donaldson Gardens – sub-surface stones left on surface after pothole repair removed.

James Robb Ave/Tom Morris Drive – potholes at junction repaired.

Lamberton Place – white line to be painted on edge of steps on public footpath as safety measure.

Balone Park – goals erected without permission in an area deemed unsuitable for football removed.

Bruce Embankment Car Park – area around cctv post weeded and to be planted with summer bedding.

Lade Braes – slope alongside path between bridge to Hallowhill and that to Canongate trimmed as nettles hanging over path. Map boards at Lawmill and Plash Mill cleaned.

Market Street – the condition of trees is being monitored. If necessary these will be replaced in the autumn.

Bike Racks – the welcome increase in cycling has meant parking space for bikes is at a premium. I am working with council officials to seek to identify new sites for racks and to arrange for the removal of abandoned bikes on existing racks.

Canongate/Bogward Road – these and a number of streets identified in the area as having a weed problem have been sprayed.

In addition -

St Andrews United – I informed the Provost of the success of St Andrews United in winning the East of Scotland Cup and he kindly wrote to the club congratulating it on its success.
