- AN referred to his email to the Planning Committee on this topic, dated 25th October. He reiterated his concerns that the CC might purchase equipment which would not be kept under CC control, but would be fixed to a wall in a room at the Students' Union, to be used for internet access to planning application detail during Planning Committee meetings. This would mean that CC's access to the equipment would be restricted to only two evenings per month, for only one purpose and in only one location. He felt that a more effective use of CC funds would be to buy a portable data projector, which could be kept under the control of the CC and used on many more occasions. JH again agreed with this view.
