**13/02255/ADV - Display of 2 internally illuminated fascia signs, 1 externally illuminated projecting sign, 2 internally illuminated menu box signs, 1 non-illuminated poster sign, 2 non-illuminated parasol signs and, 9 non-illuminated windbreak signs  
2 - 4 Logies Lane St Andrews Fife**

The Royal Burgh of St. Andrews Community Council (hereinafter “StACC”) is registering an OBJECTION to the above planning application.

The StACC OBJECTS to the use of internally illuminating fascia and menu box signs, which are contrary to the St Andrews Design Guidelines.

The StACC believes that halo lighting is inappropriate in the historic core of the burgh, and would request the use of traditional external trough lighting above the Pizza Express letters as detailed in Guideline 71. The blue LED light lines proposed by the applicant are completely inappropriate within the historic core.

Secondly, the StACC believes that the internally illuminated menu box signs are not permitted under section 6.14 of the St Andrews Design Guidelines, and should therefore not be approved. Should Pizza Express wish to have menu signs available for prospective customers, then these should be free standing signs that are not attached to the historic building.

For the above reasons, the StACC requests that the planning application is refused in its current form.
